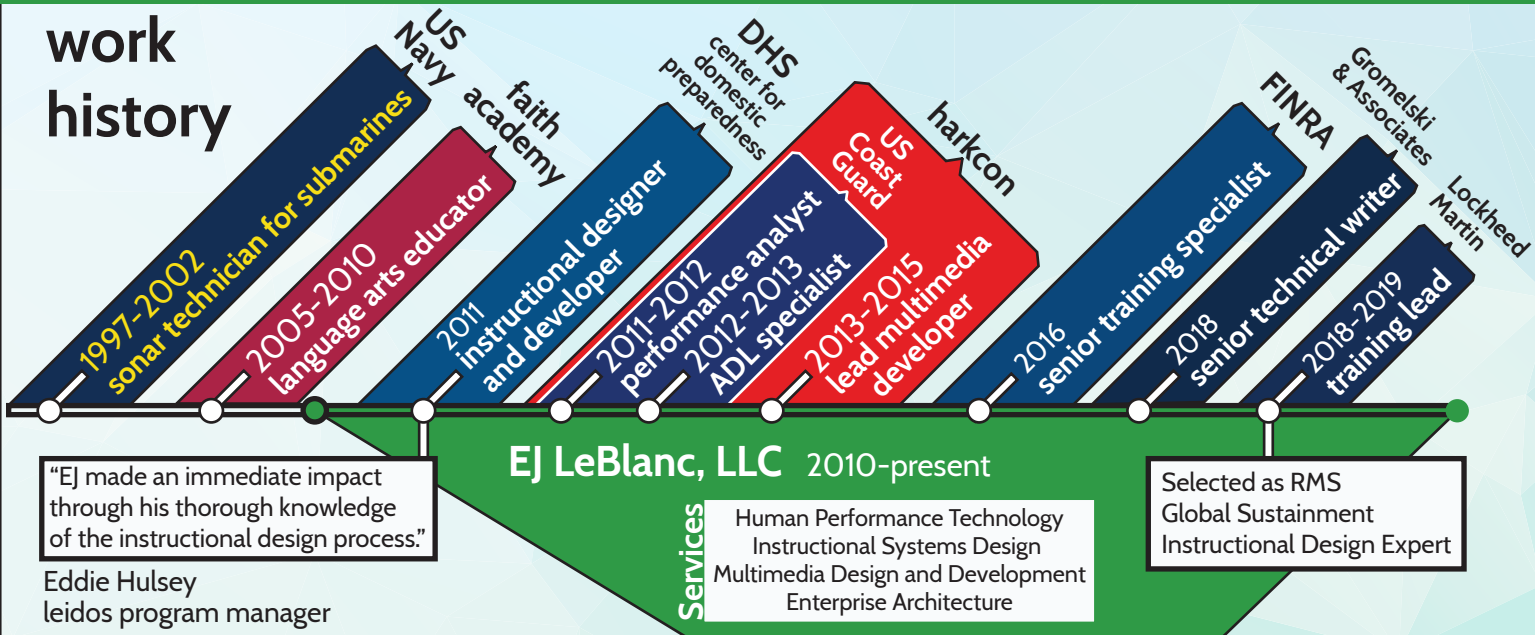

I led the effort to create a customized, Moodle-powered LMS filled with seventeen+ hours of beautiful, interactive web-based training for which I also provided all narration. This highly technical training taught officers how to sieze mobile devices, process them for evidence, and present this evidence as testimony in a court of law. Portions of the training included teaching officers to analyze deleted text messages by converting binary to hexadecimal code.

US Coast Guard Student Pilot Assessment

I identified a major need in how students were being assessed in the Coast Guard's aviation community and, after many drafts created with the client, implemented a series of interactive XML-based .PDF forms that made instructors' jobs easier: they were able to assess student performance more accurately and efficiently. I then taught others how to create and use these forms. These forms are now in widespread use throughout the CG aviation community.
